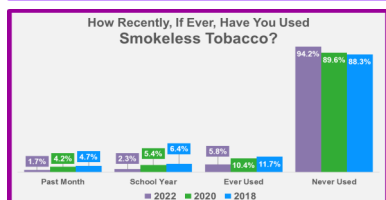
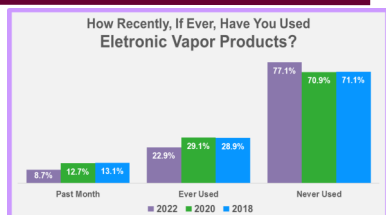
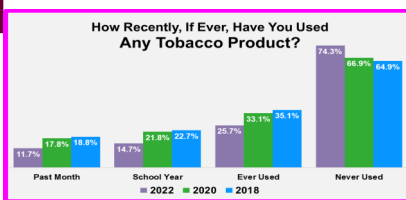


Tobacco Talk
